



## **LABORATORY SAFETY RULES**

### **DO NOT:**

1. Never work alone in the laboratory.
2. Do not eat or drink anything in the laboratory.
3. Do not place any items containing liquids on the lab benches.
4. Do not place bags, clothing, books, or similar items on the lab benches.
5. Do not sit on the lab benches.
6. Do not speak loudly.
7. Do not wear slippers, sandals, or similar footwear to the laboratory.
8. Do not engage in any activity unrelated to your experiment.
9. Do not use equipment you are not trained or familiar with.
10. Do not power up the experiment setup before the lab supervisor has checked your circuit.
11. Do not touch any machine parts if you are unsure whether they are live (powered).

### **DO:**

1. Wear appropriate clothing when coming to the laboratory.
2. Turn off the power while setting up your experiment circuits.
3. Always read the user manuals and seek help from the lab supervisor.
4. Keep the equipment turned off while assembling your circuit.
5. Turn off the power when your experiment is finished.
6. Always show the lab supervisor any connections you are unsure about.
7. Immediately inform the lab supervisor if something goes wrong during the experiment.
8. Before leaving the lab, turn off all devices and return equipment and cables to their proper places.
9. Make sure you have taken all necessary precautions to prevent electric shock during the experiment.
10. Ensure that the power supply is off when making changes to the experimental connections.
11. Keep your mobile phones turned off.
